Report from the Chairman, Debbie Constable, on the work of the Parish Council during 2011/12

Where does the time go? Must be my age as another year flies past.

Parish elections in May saw Cllr Lynne Brand stand down and Cllr Carol Parfitt elected. I would like to thank Lynne for all her hard work during her time on the Parish.

This year the Council held 5 surgeries; had a stall at the Ashingdon Carnival and Ashingdon School fete; contracts were renewed with a view to long term savings; I attended School Council meetings and the Parish has been represented at several Civic events.

The Housing Needs Survey, carried out during the summer, showed there is a need for 1/2 bedroom homes for parish residents. Once all the information was to hand the Council gave authority to Rochford Housing to carry out a land search to facilitate a small development.

The skate park project is ongoing. We are down to one contractor and design which will now be put to Rochford Council. If and when planning permission is granted the Parish will pursue grants for funding the project. A big thank-you to all the young people who have attended meetings and given valuable input.

A grant from Cory Environmental meant we were able to put 2 bench seats on the sea wall at South Fambridge. The Parish also supplied a second dog waste bin on the public right of way and, after liaising with Highways, 2 new road safety signs were installed along the Fambridge Road. In March the Council voted to support the 'Save South Fambridge Campaign'.

Our Christmas buffet was held in December with entertainment provided by Ashingdon School. A raffle was held in aid of the Royal British Legion which raised £84.60. A truly good day.

In February a memorial bench was dedicated to the former Parish Clerk Peter Murray. Several members of Peter's family attended a very poignant day.

Finally. thank-you to all the Parish Councillors for their time and input over the past year and to the Clerk for no Parish Council can function without one.
